I grew up when the Choose Your Own Adventure paperbacks were popular, and I remember using little scraps of paper to denote each branching storyline so I could read every possible outcome. Doing so with a Kindle ebook is even easier! I was already aware that the books didn't need to be read in a particular order other than the invitation at the end of each book. Books 1, 2 5 were to me the most like those CYOA books of old. The Arabian Desert of Treasures of the Forgotten City felt like a mash-up between Indiana Jones and the game Temple Run, with a little Laura Croft thrown in for good measure. Book one has more content than a few of the later books and a slightly lower price point. I was able to read every single permutation of the story in about two hours.
